4. Name the horse that won the Grand National 3 times and came 2<sup>nd</sup> twice?

6. Name the first show-jumping horse to win £1m.
7. Name this horse's first rider.

10. Name the 14.2 which competed and won a silver medal in the 1968 Olympics in Mexico. In 1967 he won the Hickstead Derby. At the age of 20 he won the Hamburg Derby. He jumped 6'8" in a puissance and in all won 61 international competitions.

13. In 1971 Harvey Smith gave the famous 'V' sign. He was riding Mattie Brown. Where was he competing?
